United Spanish War Veterans Memorial

This solitary soldier in uniform of the United States Army during the Spanish American War is known as "The Hiker." He stands sentinel along Memorial Drive heading into Arlington National Cemetery.

Arlington National Cemetery

Filled with the casualties and deceased veterans of American conflicts dating back to the Civil War, this cemetery is home to the Women in Military Services for America Memorial, John F. Kennedy's "eternal flame" and the Tomb of the Unknown

Marine Corps War Memorial

Depicting the six servicemen who raised the second U.S. flag during the WWII battle of Iwo Jima, this statue is dedicated to the Marine personnel who have died defending the United States.

Enjoy a real-life history lesson at the home of the United States Congress, a neoclassical building where laws are made, foreign policies are formed and expenditures are decided upon.
